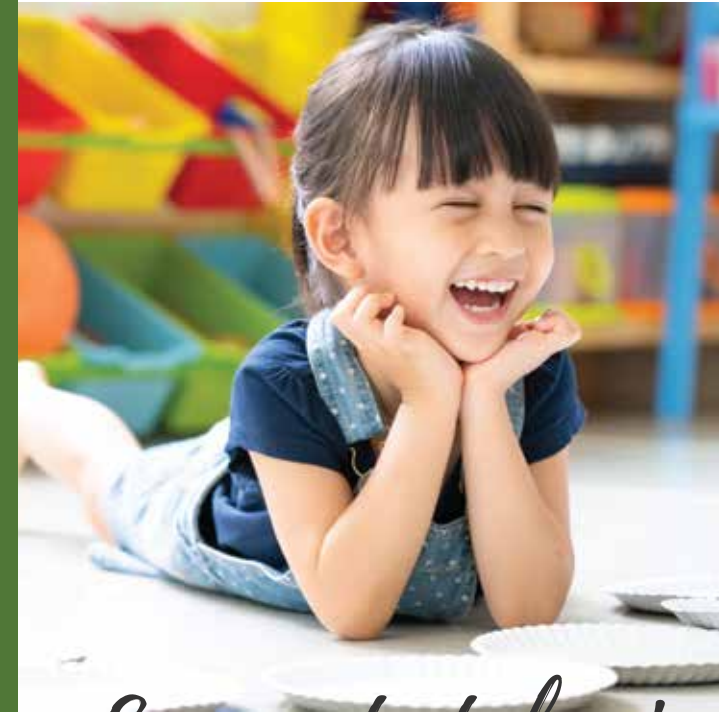

Home Visiting

Prenatal to 3 years old

Our Home Visiting program is a federal, state, and county-funded community-based program for pregnant women and families with children aged 0 to 3 years.

We offer weekly, 90 minute home visiting services, which include:

- High-quality, early childhood education.
- Parent education and involvement.
- Health, dental, and mental health resources.
- Prenatal services.
- Nutrition education.
- Family support services.
- Early intervention identification and support for children with special needs.
- Bi-monthly opportunities to connect at Socialization.



Infant, Toddler, and Preschool Services

4 months to 5 years old

We create a quality learning environment that includes children’s home language and culture while nurturing their physical, social-emotional, and cognitive growth.

Infant and Toddler childcare services are offered at Mercy Magnuson Place. There’s an average of 7-8 infants in the Infant rooms and 13-14 toddlers in the Toddler rooms with a Lead Teacher and Teaching Assistant in all rooms.

Our Preschool provides a developmentally appropriate early childhood education for children 3 to 5 years old. We have federal, state, and city funded programs and offer part-day, full-day and extended-day classrooms. Classes have an average of 18 children with a lead teacher and a teaching assistant.

Meals included at no additional cost.

Infant: 4 months – 12 months
 Toddler: 12 months – 3 years old
 Preschool: 3 – 5 years old

* Scholarships or childcare subsidy may be available based on income.



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Many of our services are FREE!

Play and Learn

Birth to 5 years old

This free, facilitated program is designed to support the development of children’s school readiness skills and to provide education and support for parents and caregivers. No enrollment is necessary, but an adult must accompany children.

Play and Learn groups are structured with child-directed free play, coordinated group activities, and intentional caregiver learning.

**If you are over-income,
you may still qualify!**

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Homeless families, foster parents, and children with special needs are categorically eligible for free services in many of our programs!
